**Honey Island Swamp Tour — Friday, January 9, Noon-4 pm — \$40 per person**

Enjoy a tour of Honey Island Swamp organized by Dr. Paul Wagner, owner and chief guide, a Ph.D. in wetland ecology who has been conducting natural history swamp tours since 1982. This tour consists of a professionally-narrated boat tour with friendly, knowledgeable guides native to South Louisiana. It includes many opportunities for nature photography and wildlife observation and is a non-commercialized explanation of Louisiana Swamp ecology and natural history. Smaller-sized boats allow access deep into the swamp interior and shallow backwater areas. Resident and migratory wildlife include alligators, bald eagles, waterfowl, herons, egrets, ibis, owls, osprey, deer, black bear, feral hogs, nutria, raccoon, otter, beaver, mink, turtles, frogs.
